

International Students & Driver's License

If you are attempting to obtain a driver's license in Northwest Arkansas then it is important to prepare the information you need to provide properly. The Department of Motor Vehicles issues all driver's licenses, but they do not have full access to the SEVIS system where your immigration information is store. Below is a list of everything you must have with you in order to obtain a United States driver's license.

Instructions

- 1. Enroll in 12 credit hours with 9 hours being live on-campus
- 2. Wait for the 2nd week of School before attempting to obtain a driver's license
- 3. Prepare the following items:
 - a. Original signed I-20
 - b. Passport
 - c. Visa
 - d. I-94
 - e. Obtain verification of enrollment from Student Services
- 4. Go to Department of Motor Vehicles and present all 5 items listed above
- 5. If not awarded driver's license on initial visit, then you may monitor your case through this website: https://www.uscis.gov/save/casecheck/
- 6. After case is completed, return to Department of Motor Vehicles and receive driver's license
 - a. Ask for your case to be looked up by your I-94 number. This will ease the process
