## Nursing Academic Exclusion Appeal (Two or more unsuccessful attempts of a required course)

Students desiring to appeal their academic exclusion to Northwest Arkansas Community College (NWACC) Nursing program must meet one of the following criteria with presentable documentation for the appeal to be considered.

- 1. Major illness, injury or long-term hospitalization of the student that prohibited successful completion of academic studies.
- 2. Major illness, injury, or long-term hospitalization of an immediate member of the student's family that prohibited successful completion of academic studies.
- 3. Unforeseen military deployment during a semester that prohibited successful completion of academic studies.
- 4. Documented situations that were beyond the students control that prohibited successful completion of academic studies.

If the applicant meets one of the above criteria, the following must be done to have the appeal considered. Incomplete or inaccurate information will delay or disqualify the appeal.
