Prior Learning Springdale Schools

ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE IN GENERAL TECHNOLOGY

Students taking specified course work through Springdale Schools can request prior learning credit from the Dean of Workforce.

PROGRAM DESIGN

- A. NWACC will only accept 30 hours of prior learning toward and associate degree which requires 60 hours. Only fifty percent (50%) of certificate requirements can be from prior learning.
- B. Students must complete 15 credit hours of coursework at NWACC to earn an associate degree and 25% of the credit hours required for a certificate program.
- C. NWACC will award prior learning credit for Springdale courses <u>upon successful completion</u> of the following courses toward the AAS in Gen Tech, AAS in Construction Technology, and/or the Plumbing and Electrical Apprenticeship, provided students are in the NCCER registry and have successfully completed all of the quizzes, tests, and performance profiles.
